ORDER

FORFEITURE OF COLLATERAL SCHEDULE  
(Army Corps of Engineers)

The following amendment to the Forfeiture of Collateral Schedule is hereby ordered and made effective in the Northern District of Oklahoma as of the date of the filing of this Order.

Pursuant to Rule 58(d), Federal Rules of Criminal Procedures, and Local Rule 34 of the United States District Court for the Northern District of Oklahoma, the Court hereby orders that the petty offenses for which collateral may be posted and forfeited in lieu of appearance by the person charged, together with the amount of the collateral to be posted at facilities under the charge and control of the Army Corps of Engineers are as follows:

Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter III, Section 327



327.12(d)	Using any audio equipment or other noise producing device in such a manner as to annoy or endanger other persons at any time	\$75
327.13	Possession of loaded firearm, ammunition, loaded projectile firing device, bows and arrows, crossbows, explosives or explosive devices of any kind, including fireworks unless permitted	\$100


