GENERAL ORDER

Be advised that this Court is participating in a pilot program pursuant to which, for a limited period of time, certain documents filed in criminal cases will be electronically available to the general public via the Internet.

Counsel, parties, pro se and any other person preparing or filing a document in a criminal matter should not include certain types of sensitive information in any document filed with the court unless such inclusion is necessary and relevant to the case in which it is filed. If sensitive information must be included, certain personal and identifying information, such as social security numbers, financial account numbers, dates of birth and the names of minor children, must be redacted in the document.

Counsel shall share this information with all clients so that an informed decision about the inclusion, redaction and/or exclusion of certain information may be made. It is the sole responsibility of counsel, parties, pro se and any other person preparing or filing a document to be sure that the document complies with this redaction requirement. The Clerk of the Court will not review each document for redaction. Counsel, the parties, pro se and any other person preparing or filing a document are cautioned that failure to redact personal

identifiers and/or the inclusion of irrelevant **personal** information in a document or exhibit filed with the court may subject them to **full disciplinary** and remedial power of the court.




