ORDER

This matter comes before the Court pursuant to the United States Supreme Court's decision in Blakely v. Washington, 2004 WL 1402697 (U.S. Wash.), entered June 24, 2004. The United States District Court for the Northern District of Oklahoma is considering a moratorium on sentencing and change of plea proceedings until the potential impact of Blakely upon cases on the criminal docket can be fully analyzed. In furtherance of this effort, the Court directs the United States Attorney to identify to the Clerk of Court any case in which a delay would possibly occasion a violation of the Speedy Trial Act.
