ORDER

IT IS THE ORDER of the Court that the following condition entitled "Special Mental Health Condition" shall apply to persons placed on probation or supervised release when deemed reasonable and specifically ordered by the Court based on the nature and circumstances of the instant offense(s) and the defendant's history and characteristics. Such condition furthers the statutory goals of sentencing by protecting the public from further crimes of the defendant and providing the defendant with needed medical or mental health care or other correctional treatment in the most effective manner. The Special Mental Health Condition shall read as follows:

The defendant shall participate in a program of mental health treatment, to include inpatient, with a treatment provider and on a schedule approved by the probation officer. The defendant shall waive any right of confidentiality in any records for mental health treatment to allow the probation officer to review the course of treatment and progress with the treatment provider.
