**GENERAL ORDER**

Any person charged with a misdemeanor or petty offense as defined in 18 U.S.C. § 19 may, in lieu of appearance, post collateral with the Central Violations Bureau ([www.cvb.uscourts.gov](http://www.cvb.uscourts.gov)) in the fixed or maximum amount indicated for the offense and consent to forfeiture of collateral to end said case. Fed. R. Crim. P. 58(d); LCrR58-1. The fixed or maximum amounts for which collateral may be posted for various offenses are either published in the Code of Federal Regulations or contained in written schedules on file with the Clerk of Court and are typically stated on the violation notice (the charge). Any person or organization charged with a misdemeanor or petty offense for which there is not a published schedule must appear before a United States District or Magistrate Judge.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that in accordance with Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 58(d) and Rule 58-1 of this Court's Local Criminal Rules, the Court GRANTS the *Government's Motion to Adopt Updated Forfeiture of Collateral Schedules* [Dkt. No. 1, filed in Case No. 26-MC-6] and ADOPTS the attached Schedules "A" through "D," which provide for forfeiture of collateral in lieu

of appearance for satisfaction of certain petty offense violations issued by the Army Corps of Engineers (Schedule “A”); the Department of Veterans Affairs (Schedule “B”); the Fish and Wildlife Service (Schedule “C”); and the Department of Homeland Security – Federal Protective Service (Schedule “D”). The Clerk of Court is directed to keep on file Schedules “A” through “D” and make them available for public inspection.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the United States Attorney’s Office for the Northern District of Oklahoma may, from time to time as needed, and in coordination with applicable agencies and in compliance with federal laws and regulations, prepare updated forfeiture of collateral schedules and shall file a motion in Case No. 26-MC-6 requesting the Court to adopt updated written schedules.
