RULES FOR USE

- Use this procedure when declining magistrate judge jurisdiction in Social Security cases assigned to a magistrate judge as the presiding officer at case opening.
- Do not use this procedure to submit consents to magistrate judge jurisdiction in Social Security cases assigned to a district judge or in non-social security cases. Instead, submit the consents for these cases using the <u>Procedure for Submitting</u> <u>Proposed Documents</u>, available on the Court's website.
