

LCrR32.1 – Revoking or Modifying Probation or Supervised Release

LCrR32.1-1 Revocations.

The ~~Court~~-Clerk of Court should file under seal any petition and order for warrant or summons for a violation of pretrial release, probation, or post-conviction supervised release and shall seal the subsequent warrant or summons issued. Upon execution of the warrant or summons, the United States Marshals Service and/or the United States Probation Office shall disclose the petition and order for warrant or summons to the defendant and counsel for the defendant. Following the ~~i~~nitial ~~a~~Appearance, the ~~United States m~~Magistrate ~~j~~udge shall advise the ~~Court~~-Clerk's office and they shall unseal the petition and order and the issued warrant or summons.
