

LCvR38 – Right to a Jury Trial; Demand

LCvR38-1 Jury Demand.

If a party demands a jury trial by endorsing it on a pleading, as permitted by ~~Fed. R. Civ. P. rule 38(b) of the Fed. R. Civ. P.~~, a notation shall be placed on the front page of the pleading, immediately following the title of the pleading, stating “Jury Trial Demanded.” This notation will serve as a sufficient demand under ~~Fed. R. Civ. P. Rule~~ 38(b). See LCvR-81-1 relative to removed cases.
