


ORDER


IT IS THE ORDER of the Court that the following condition entitled “Special Immigration and Customs Enforcement Condition” shall apply to illegal aliens placed on supervised release when deemed reasonable and specifically ordered by the Court based on the nature and circumstances of the instant offense and the defendant’s history and characteristics. Such condition furthers the statutory goals of sentencing by affording adequate deterrence to criminal conduct, protecting the public from further crimes of the defendant, and promoting respect for the law. The Special Immigration and Customs Enforcement Condition shall read as follows:


As a condition of supervised release, upon completion of his or her term of imprisonment, the defendant is to be surrendered to a duly-authorized immigration official for deportation proceedings in accordance with the established procedures provided by the Immigration and Nationality Act, 8 U.S.C. §§ 1101-1524. If the defendant is not deported or serves any portion of supervised release within the United States for any reason, the defendant shall report immediately to the United States Probation Office in the district of release to begin the term of supervised release.
