
ORDER


IT IS THE ORDER of the Court that the following condition entitled “Special Mental Health Condition” shall apply to persons placed on probation or supervised release when deemed reasonable and specifically ordered by the Court based on the nature and circumstances of the instant offense(s) and the defendant’s history and characteristics. Said condition furthers the statutory goals of sentencing by protecting the public from further crimes of the defendant and providing the defendant with needed medical or mental health care or other correctional treatment in the most effective manner. The Special Mental Health Condition shall read as follows:


The defendant shall successfully participate in a program of mental health treatment and follow the rules and regulations of the program. The probation officer, in consultation with the treatment provider, will determine the treatment modality, location, and treatment schedule. The defendant shall waive any right of confidentiality in any records for mental health treatment to allow the probation officer to review the course of treatment and progress with the treatment provider. The defendant must pay the costs of the program or assist (co-payment) in payment of the costs of the program if financially able.
