

This general order amends and supercedes general order 20-26. Due to the increase in the criminal caseload, the Federal Public Defender will, on occasion, assign representation of criminal defendants to out-of-district Federal Public Defender offices. When Federal Public Defender attorneys from other districts are assigned to a case, the Clerk of Court is directed to deem them admitted to practice in this District, and waive the requirement that they complete an attorney admission application or file a motion to proceed pro hac vice.

IT IS SO ORDERED this 9th day of November, 2020.




