GENERAL ORDER 22-03


Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(f), in an emergency and upon the concurrence of the chief judges of the districts involved, a United States magistrate judge may be temporarily assigned to perform any of the duties specified in subsection (a), (b), or (c) of Section 636 in a judicial district other than the judicial district for which he or she has been appointed. No magistrate judge shall perform any of such duties in a district to which he or she has been temporarily assigned until an order has been issued by the chief judge of such district specifying (1) the emergency by reason of which the magistrate judge is being transferred, (2) the duration of his or her assignment, and (3) the duties which he or she is authorized to perform.

The Northern District of Oklahoma certifies the need for periodic emergency assistance from the Honorable Beth M. Deere, a magistrate judge in the Eastern District of Arkansas, to perform the duties designated under 28 U.S.C. § 636, subsections (a), (b), and (c). The emergency in the district is that there has been a significant and permanent increase in felony filings resulting from the Supreme Court's decision in *McGirt v. Oklahoma*, 591 U.S. ___, 140 S. Ct. 2452 (2020). During this time, there is a need for visiting magistrate judges to assist with matters, primarily felony preliminary proceedings and pretrial felony matters, on an emergency basis. The Northern District of Oklahoma further certifies that it will coordinate its requirements with the Honorable Beth M. Deere

so that her assistance will not conflict with the performance of her current assignments to the Eastern District of Arkansas.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, with the concurrence of the Honorable D. P. Marshall Jr., Chief Judge of the Eastern District of Arkansas, that United States Magistrate Judge Beth M. Deere is designated to hold court and perform other judicial duties under 28 U.S.C. § 636, subsections (a), (b), and (c), in the Northern District of Oklahoma from February 7, 2022 to July 31, 2022, and for such further time as may be required for the judge to complete unfinished business that was “assigned to the judge during her designated period.”
