POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT Assistant Federal Public Defender - Trial Unit

The Federal Public Defender for the Western District of Oklahoma is accepting applications for the position of Assistant Federal Public Defender for our Trial Unit in Oklahoma City. The Federal Public Defender operates under authority of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 3006A(g)(2)(A). We provide legal services by court appointment to individuals unable to afford counsel. We represent our clients from first appearance through petitioning the United States Supreme Court for certiorari.

ASSISTANT FEDERAL PUBLIC DEFENDER. Must be a law school graduate, a member in good standing of any State bar, and either admitted or eligible for admission in the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Oklahoma, the Tenth Circuit Court of Appeals, and the Supreme Court. Minimum of three years' criminal trial experience required (preferably federal), as well as strong research and writing skills, in-depth knowledge of criminal law and procedure, and a commitment to the representation of those unable to afford counsel. A successful applicant should be ready to assume responsibilities as lead counsel in pending federal felony cases. Salary negotiable within the range permitted by policy, depending on experience. Our salaries are comparable to those paid by U.S. Attorney's Office. We are at will employees. Full federal benefits including health insurance, life insurance, Thrift Savings Plan, and paid leave accrued per pay period.

This is a different position from our previous announcement, which closed March 18, 2022. The resumes and/or applications received in response to the previous announcement will automatically be considered unless we are notified otherwise by the applicant. We will be interviewing and extending an offer for this announcement to enable an entry on duty on or before **June 1, 2022**.
